How do you keep your hansgrohe's bathroom products in the best conditions? Read on for important tips to take care of your bathroom products below.

### Follow the cleaning recommendation instruction manual closely

- Carry out cleaning of bathroom products with the prescribed detergent dosage, duration, specific to the objects and tailored to the products' needs.
- Use cleaning agent and material which is explicitly provided for this type of application.

# Beware of cleaning agents and abrasive cleaning materials

Using the wrong cleaning agents and abrasive cleaning materials could cause considerable damage to the surfaces and affect the inner workings of the products!

- Do not mix different cleaning agents and avoid using cleaning agents which contain hydrochloric acid, formic acid, chlorine bleaching lye or acetic acid
- Never use cleaning materials or appliances with an abrasive effect, such as unsuitable cleaning powders, sponge pads or micro fibre cloths

#### Watch out for limescale deposits

**Limescale** is a calcium compound found on surfaces of products with regular contact with water. Limescale deposits are unsightly and can accumulate quickly which reduce efficiency of your shower products!

 Clean your bathroom products regularly to remove the limescale deposits for regular water flow and longer product life and functionality!

Instead of vigorously cleaning and scrubbing the products, you can **simply rub the flexible silicone nubs** on our shower jets and remove the limescale deposits.





# Always thoroughly rinse the shower products with clean water after use

Residues of your toiletries such as shampoos, shower gels and liquid soaps or even hair dyes, perfumes, aftershave and nail varnish can cause damage to your bathroom fittings.

What you should do: Always carefully rinse your bathroom fittings with water after use to remove residues.

### Never spray directly on the shower products with a spray cleaner

Spraying directly onto the bathroom products could cause the atomised spray to enter openings and gaps in the product and cause damage. So remember to spray the cleaning solution onto a soft cloth or sponge, but never directly onto the shower products!
