Creating a shower system will be made easier and more enjoyable with thorough planning prior to installation. By exploring all the options first, you can have a pleasant experience in the design and specification of your system as well as in using it.

What elements are needed to create a shower system?

- Showerhead
- Handshower
- Wall Outlet
- Bodyspray
- Wallbar
- Shower Trim (Select One): ShowerSelect Thermostatic Trim for 1 Function, ShowerSelect Thermostatic Trim for 2 Functions,
 Standard Thermostatic with Volume Control, Standard Thermostatic with Volume Control and Diverter
- Diverter (Select one): Trio 2-Way Diverter, Quattro 3-Way Diverter, Quattro Green 3-Way Diverter

Commonly questions to ask before planning a shower system:

- What do I want from my shower? Relaxation, invigoration?
- Where can I put a shower system? How much space will I need?
- How much do I want to spend? How much will I need to spend?
- What are the parts and components that I will need?
- How will all the valves and controls work together?
- What about the water supply, drainage and other practical considerations?
- Have I considered all possible users? Children, elderly users?
- Are there any special requirements, like access for the mobility challenged?

What should be taken into account when designing a shower system?

• Budget: Determine a budget for creating your shower system.

Space: Showers can range in size from about 30" x 30" to any customized dimension.
 Enclosures: Enclosures contain splashing and create a more private space, but they are not a necessity when designing a shower system. An open plan can offer many possibilities.

• Water Volume: Determine the water volume you to have for your custom shower.

The Flow Rate Work Sheet will help you with this.

• Water Flow: We recommend 40 - 65 PSI for a shower system to operate properly.

Your plumber or contractor can help you verify your average dynamic water pressure and volume capacity of your

plumbing system.

• Water Heater: It is important to ensure sufficient hot water supply. Here again, the Flow Rate Work Sheet

will help you estimate the throughput of a system.

• Floor Drain: Install a drain (or multiple drains) that can handle twice the amount of water

as all components combined provide.

• Local Codes: Local plumbing codes vary greatly from location to location, and not all products may be installed in all locations.

Be sure to know and follow your local plumbing codes and make product selections accordingly.

• Time: Installation time may also be a factor, especially on do-it-yourself jobs. For peace of mind and efficiency,

we recommend that shower systems be installed by a licensed plumber.


^{*}Note: Diverters are optional. They are needed when more than 2 functions are desired.


